**Travel to Copenhagen**

**By Plane**

Copenhagen is easily accessible by air. The city centre, Marriott Hotel and surrounding hotels are conveniently reached from the airport within 30 minutes by taxi or train to Central Station.

## Once at the airport there are a number of ways to travel to the city centre.....

### Train from Kastrup, the Airport, to Central Station in 12 minutes

Beneath Terminal 3, which is where you arrive and pass through customs, there is a train station. From here you have a twelve minute train ride to Central Station in Copenhagen - in Danish called *Hovedbanegården*. During the day these trains run regularly every ten minutes.

Turning right out of the station, The Marriott Hotel is a 5-10 minute walk along Bernstorffsgade.

### Train fare or CPHCARD

Tickets are bought at the ticket counter in Terminal 3 just before going down the stairs, by elevator or escalator to the station platform below - the fare is DKK 27\*, if you have Danish change, you can purchase them at a ticket machine or over the counter.

There is, however, also the possibility of purchasing a **CPHCARD**, which you can use during your stay. In addition to free entrance to 60 attractions and discounts, this card gives you free transportation in the Greater Copenhagen area including to and from the airport.
