his *second edition* Masterclass in Imaging of Gynaecological Cancers is a highly commended one-day teaching course which will highlight current imaging techniques, image interpretation and pitfalls in imaging gynaecological malignancies. Workshop-style teaching with individual imaging workstations in small groups will provide participants with a stimulating and highly interactive learning experience.

The faculty comprises experts in gynaecological imaging who will focus on particular aspects in the management of gynaecological cancer. The sessions will be dedicated to reviewing the role and interpretation of imaging in the patient pathway from diagnosis and staging through to treatment and complications in gynaecological cancers. This course is brand new for 2017, featuring all new cases.

The course is limited to 40 participants, split between two parallel workshops running concurrently. Each of the four 1.5 hour sessions will commence with a 20 minute lecture followed by mentored review of radiological cases, each chosen with specific learning points. A comprehensive workbook is provided to enhance learning.

Places are limited to 40 participants and will be sold on a first come first served basis. Do book early to avoid disappointment. Please note that registration will not be confirmed until the registration fee is paid.

Attendees will receive a certificate showing 6 (category 1) CPD points awarded by the **Royal College of Radiologists**.

- 1. Role of imaging in the diagnosis and evaluation of gynaecological malignancy
- 2. To understand and apply the FIGO staging system
- 3. To appreciate the application of imaging in deciding treatment options for gynaecological cancers
- 4. To assess treatment response, complication of treatment and detection of recurrent disease
