Call for Editor-in-Chief, *Cancer Imaging*

The Trustees of ICIS hereby invite applications for the role of Editor-in-Chief for the Society journal, *Cancer Imaging*. With an impact factor of 4.9, *Cancer Imaging* is placed in the top quartile of radiology, nuclear medicine & medical imaging journals and Q2 for oncology journals. The journal publishes peer-reviewed original articles, reviews and editorials written by expert international radiologists working in oncology, and encompasses CT, MR, PET, ultrasound, radionuclide and multimodal imaging in all kinds of malignant tumours, plus new developments, techniques and innovations.

In line with the Society, *Cancer Imaging* aims to be a scientific and educational resource for all those working in this specialist field and to be at the forefront of dissemination of knowledge worldwide. As a fully open-access journal, article accesses reached over 1 million during 2023, demonstrating the journal's success and standing in a very competitive field. All articles published in *Cancer Imaging* are made freely and permanently accessible online immediately upon publication, without subscription charges or registration barriers.

The current Editor-in-Chiefs will conclude their terms of office in September 2024 and the Trustees would like to recruit a successor for handover at that time.

The main responsibilities of the Editor-in-Chief of *Cancer Imaging* are to oversee all editorial processes and to be responsible for the editorial integrity of the journal. The Editor-in-Chief will be expected to plan a strategy for development of the journal, to communicate with the Editorial Board and direct engagement of reviewers, and to collaborate with the BMC Publishing Editor.

The role has a four-year term with the option to extend for one further year by mutual consent with the Trustees; expressions of interest and applications are invited, and is open to all those with expertise in oncological imaging, experience of scientific leadership in a renowned academic or research institution, and previous journal experience.

Applications should be submitted to the ICIS Office, c/o Maureen Watts [maureen.watts@cancerimagingociety.org.uk] and should include a CV, vision statement and names of two referees. *The closing date for applications is Sunday 12 May 2024.*
